



**Student Government Resolution 112.019
A Resolution in Support of Purchasing Recycle Bins
Sponsored by the Environmental Affairs Committee**

WHEREAS,

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long-term best interest of the Student Association in the formulation of the University policy and in the fulfillment of the University mission; and
- The Student Government website has offered an online form since no later than Spring 2011 for students to request recycling bins¹; and
- Recycling bins have not been purchased for the 2011-2012 school year to hand-out to students; and
- As of December 2011, Student Government has under 15 remaining recycling bins for student use; and
- The Student Government fall budget allots \$2,500 for the purchase of recycling bins²; and
- The 2010 Student Vision Document, passed with unanimous support in the spring of 2010, states “We would like to increase the number of recycling bins around campus as past distributions were well received³.”

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT,

- Supports the promotion of recycling and environmental sustainability on campus through the purchase of additional recycling bins for students.

THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT OF TRUMAN STATE UNIVERSITY DIRECTS THAT,

- Directs that no more than \$2,500 towards purchasing new recycle bins for the upcoming Semester; and
- Additional copies of this resolution are disseminated to President Troy Paino, Dean of Student Affairs Lou Ann Gilchrist, and the Truman Media Network.
