



Student Government Resolution 113.003
A Resolution Launching a Massive Campus Voter Registration Drive
Sponsored by Aaron Malin, President of the Student Association

WHEREAS,

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long-term best interest of the Student Association in the formulation of the University policy and in the fulfillment of the University mission; and
- Truman State University currently has a large quantity of students that are not registered to vote¹; and
- Increasing democratic participation is vital to the interests of the University; and
- A massive voter registration drive could significantly increase voter registration rates at Truman; and
- As a public institution, Truman State University has an obligation to serve the state of Missouri; and
- A way to fulfill the public obligation of the University is to register voters.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT:

- Hereby declares the period of time between September 17, 2012 and October 10, 2012 the “Student Senate Voter Registration Marathon”; and
- The goal of said registration drive is to register 500 students as Adair County Registered Voters; and
- The Student Senate Voter Registration Marathon is to be entirely non-partisan, and under no circumstance is a Senator that is registering voters permitted to ask questions of party affiliation.
