



**Student Government Resolution 113.005
A Resolution in Support of Purchasing Recycle Bins
Sponsored by the Environmental Affairs Committee**

WHEREAS,

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long-term best interest of the Student Association in the formulation of the University policy and in the fulfillment of the University mission; and
- The Student Government website has offered an online form since no later than Spring 2011 for students to request recycling bins; and
- Recycling bins have not been purchased for the 2012-2013 school year to hand-out to students; and
- As of August 2012, Student Government has run out of recycling bins to hand out to students because of high demand; and
- The Student Government budget allots funds for the purchase of recycling bins; and
- The 2010 Student Vision Document, passed with unanimous support in the spring of 2010, states "We would like to increase the number of recycling bins around campus as past distributions were well received."

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT:

- Supports the promotion of recycling and environmental sustainability on campus through the purchase of additional recycling bins for students.

THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT OF TRUMAN STATE UNIVERSITY DIRECTS THAT:

- Directs that no more than \$2,000 be spent towards the purchase of 500 new recycle bins for the upcoming semester by October 24, 2012; and
- Additional copies of this resolution are disseminated to President Troy Paino, Dean of Student Affairs Lou Ann Gilchrist, Pickler Memorial Library Office of Special Collection, and the Truman Media Network
