**A Resolution Designating the New Standing Rules of Student Government
Sponsored by Molly Turner, President of the Student Association; Jeremy "JJ"
Dorrell, Vice President of the Student Association; Stephen Baumgartner,
Presidential Aide**

WHEREAS,

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long-term best interests of the Student Association in the formulation of University policy and in the fulfillment of the University mission; and
- The Standing Rules currently do not include a Historian position; and
- There are tasks that can be completed in order to better preserve historical documentation of the Student Government through creating a Vision Document, archiving meeting minutes, committee reports, and resolutions both physically and electronically, cataloguing components of the *Index* Campus Newspaper, registering posters distributed by the Student Government, and acting in other way the Historian feels they can adequately capture the history of the Student Government; and
- Making necessary changes to the Student Government Standing Rules regarding the Historian position will ensure the body's ability to address the need of historical preservation within the Student Government.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,

- By approving this resolution, the Senate is approving these changes of the Truman State University Student Government Standing Rules; and
- These rules shall be considered effective immediately pending approval.
