



**Student Government Resolution 117.0017**  
**A Resolution Extending the Deadline for the Environmental Sustainability Fee**  
**Accountability Committee**  
**Sponsored by Sarah Holtmeyer, Student Government Vice President; and Kyle Weber,**  
**Environmental Sustainability Accountability Fee Committee Chair**

WHEREAS,

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long term best interests of the Student Association in the formulation of the University policy and in the fulfillment of the University mission; and
- The Environmental Sustainability Fee Accountability Committee Operating Procedures, Section 3, Sub-Section 1, Clause 3, states that a slate must be brought forward by the final full-body Student Government meeting in the month of March<sup>1</sup>; and
- Kyle Weber was appointed as chair of the Environmental Sustainability Fee Accountability Committee on January 28, 2018; and
- Because of this late appointment, the committee has only had four weeks to create a slate; and
- This slate cannot be put together hastily and requires many hours of thought and research before being brought before the Student Government general body.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT,

- Acknowledges that the March deadline outlined by the Operating Procedures will be impossible to meet; and
- Extends the deadline for the 2017-2018 slate review; and
- Requires this committee to present their slate by April 15, 2018.

THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT DIRECTS THAT,
