



Student Government Resolution 117.0024
A Resolution Approving Spring 2018 Ballot Language for the Athletic Fee
Sponsored by Kyra Cooper, President of the Student Association

WHEREAS,

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long-term best interests of the Student Association in the formulation of University policy and in the fulfillment of the University mission; and
- The Athletic Fee Accountability Committee has pursued changing its Operating Procedures in order to accommodate non-intercollegiate athletic groups that may require funding; and
- The Athletic Fee Accountability Committee needs a vote of the student body in order to alter the rules governing the dispersion of the Athletic Fee.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT,

- The following two statements are included in the Spring of 2018 election are included as separate measures for students on which to vote:
 1. I support that beginning in the 2018-2019 academic year, the Athletic Fee may allocate up to 10% of short-term project funding to projects proposed by non-intercollegiate athletics, with the potential of an additional 5% of short-term project funding with a $\frac{2}{3}$ approval vote of the Athletic Fee Accountability committee.
 2. I support that beginning in the 2018-2019 academic year, the Athletic Fee should keep 3% of the short-term project funding in reserve for any necessary additional funding of projects.
