



Student Government Resolution 115.001
A Resolution in Opposition to a Credit/No Credit Disclosure Policy
Sponsored by President Drew Paulman and Academic Affairs Chair Clayton Berry

WHEREAS,

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long term best interests of the Student Association in the formulation of the University policy and in the fulfillment of the University mission; and
- Currently, professors are not notified when a student changes a class to "no credit;" and
- A credit / no credit disclosure policy may cause students to feel professors will treat and /or grade them differently from their peers; and
- This may cause additional stress upon students; and
- Students have the right to academic privacy; and
- It is the students responsibility to seek assistance if they are unsure of whether to take a class for credit / no credit; and
- A credit / no credit disclosure policy may turn some students away from exploring other classes in fear of academic discrimination.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT,

- Opposes the implementation of a credit / no credit disclosure policy.
