



Student Government Resolution 116.021
A Resolution to Amend the By-Laws of the Funds Allotment Council
Associate Senator Jake Buxton and FAC Chair Taylor Schulz

WHEREAS,

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long term best interests of the Student Association in the formulation of the University policy and in the fulfillment of the University mission; and
- The Constitution of the Student Government states under Article V, Section 3 regarding Independent Councils: "Amendments of the by-laws of independent councils shall proceed as another piece of legislation"; and
- The Funds Allotment Council, an Independent Council, has voted to amend their standing rules within the Council; and
- For the changes to their by-laws to take effect, Student Government must vote with a simple majority to accept the changes requested by the Funds Allotment Council.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,

- That the Student Government accepts the following changes brought forth by the Funds Allotment Council to their by-laws:
 - Add to Article V, section 4 a clause to be called "Clause 5" that will read: "Upon approval of the slate by the Council, the Council shall present within two weeks' time the Council approved slate to Student Senate at Student Senate's weekly meeting.
 - Under Article XI, strike Sections one and two and replace with the following to be labeled "Section 1": "Amendments to these By-Laws may be made by a 6/9 vote of the Council."
