Student Government Athletic Fee Accountability Committee Project Slate Proposals for the 2015-2016 Academic Year Sponsored by Molly Turner, President of the Student Association; Cate Simon, Chair of the Athletic Fee Accountability Committee; Matt Peterson, Male Varsity Athlete Representative to the Athletic Fee Accountability Committee; and Linnea Schmelzer, Female Varsity Athlete Representative to the Athletic Fee Accountability Committee

WHEREAS,

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long term best interest of the Student Association in the formulation of University policy and in the fulfillment of the University mission; and
- Athletics are an important part of campus life at Truman State University and help to
 promote the mission of the University through aiding in the recruitment of athletes,
 developing and encouraging the engagement of future students and alumni, and
 promoting health and wellness of the Truman student association; and
- Truman State University currently has the Athletic Fee which brings in \$58.00 per student for the 2015-2016 academic year; and
- The Athletic Fee has been on Truman State University's campus since 2007; and
- The Athletic Fee currently generates approximately \$625,000 annually; and
- The purpose of the Athletic Fee is to further recreational, club and varsity athletics; and
- On Tuesday, February 2nd the Athletic Accountability Fee Committee held a meeting to vote on the slate of projects; and
- Following the Athletic Accountability Fee Committee Operating Procedures as stated in Section 2, Sub-Section 1, Clause 5, the proposed slate of projected was determined by a majority vote of those voting members on the committee; and
- The projects and monetary values approved by the committee are as following: Indoor protective screens for baseball and softball for \$2,500; on field baseball batting cage for \$5,500; new shot clocks in the Pershing building for \$15,000; soccer press box and bleachers for \$100,000; two basketball shooting machines for \$13,000; permanent bleachers at baseball and softball fields for \$50,000; foul poles and dugout fencing at the softball field for \$10,000; new cardio machines in the auxiliary weight room for \$15,000; and the maintenance fee for \$15,000; and
- Along with the projects and monetary values above, in compliance with "A Resolution to Endorse the Athletic Fee Accountability Committee's Long-Term Project Selection: "Turf and Track Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC) Championship Tournament Conference Project" on Truman State University's Campus" passed on Sunday, April 12th, 2015, 40% of the annual Athletic Fee budget will be set aside for the project to be completed.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,

• That the Student Government approve the Athletic Fee Accountability Committee project slate for the 2015-2016 academic year.
