Student Government Resolution 116.036

A Resolution Amending the Standing Rules of Student Government Sponsored by the Environmental Affairs Committee Chair Liam Hazen and Committee Members Elisabeth Condon, Andrew Ferrini, Andrew Herdman, Wyatt Mansell, and Adrian Wheeler

WHEREAS,

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long term best interests of the Student Association in the formulation of the University policy and in the fulfillment of the University mission; and
- The Environmental Affairs Committee is bound by the Article 1, Section 13, Clause 2 of the Standing Rules of the Student Government to hold a battery recycling drive once a semester; and
- The Environmental Affairs Committee is working to implement a year-round battery recycling drive with Residence Life; and
- The battery recycling drive held by the Environmental Affairs Committee in Spring 2016 gathered over 40 pounds of batteries for recycling; and
- The Environmental Affairs Committee thinks a year-round battery recycling drive would collect even more batteries than a drive each semester.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT,

- Amends Article I, Section 13, Clause 2 of the Standing Rules of Student Government to say:
 - o "The Environmental Affairs Committee, in coordination with Residence Life and other appropriate authorities, shall organize, promote, and execute year-round battery recycling."; and
- Acknowledges the work of the 2015-2016 Environmental Affairs Committee in executing the battery recycling drive in Spring 2016.
