



## **An Executive Order Establishing A Women's Leadership Conference Ad Hoc Committee of the Student Government**

### **WHEREAS,**

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long term best interest of the Student Association in the formulation of the University policy and in the fulfillment of the University mission; and
- Truman State University is currently at an opportune time to encourage and celebrate female leadership on campus; and
- A Women's Leadership Conference would effectively collesce the current state of the University with tangible benefits for the Truman community; and
- The creation of a committee to oversee a Women's Leadership Conference would allow for cohesion and organization in its planning process.
- Student Government planned and executed a successful Women's Leadership Conference during the 2017-2018 academic year;
- Student Government reached out to the Women and Gender Studies Conference Planning Committee to inquire about collaborating on a single conference in spring 2019; and
- The Women and Gender Studies Conference Planning Committee agreed to collaborate, planning to host two conferences in conjunction with each other on the same day in the same building with joint keynote speeches, networking events, and hospitality rooms; and
- The creation of a committee to oversee the planning and hosting of this conference will help to coordinate Student Government's involvement and ensure the conference's actualization and quality.

### **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT,**

- I, Keaton Leppanen, President of the Student Association, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Standing Rules of the Student Government, do hereby issue this executive order to establish a Women's Leadership Ad Hoc Committee of the Student Government; and
- Charge this committee with collaborating with the Women and Gender Studies Conference Planning Committee to plan a Women's Leadership Conference in February of 2019.
