a. Roll Call

Auxiliary Reports

- **a.** Speaker of the Student Senate
 - i. No report.
- b. Academic Affairs Chair
 - i. I had a meeting with Dr. Gooch, and we talked about Safe Zone training and the commencement speaker
 - 1. Looking at dates and rooms on Thursday (Oct. 24) for the commencement speaker.
 - ii. Check out the theater's Dryland performance!
 - iii. Questions:
 - 1. Schmidt: We talked through all of those project ideas and Janna/Dr. Thomas gave us ideas about Safe Zone, what about Dr. Gooch?
 - a. Meyer: She mostly gave me dates for it, but she also wants faculty who has done the training before to do it again.
 - b. Schmidt: Dr. Thomas and Janna don't think they can legally get all professors to do the Safe Zone training and also they can argue that religion conflicts with training. There's also a thought that if all professors do the training then it might lose the meaning of the training.
 - Meyer: There's an idea of a student-oriented Safe Zone training for SA's or organization presidents.
- c. Diversity Committee Chair
