



**Student Government Resolution 119.033**

**A Resolution in Support of Maps Outlining Student Access to Services in Academic Buildings**

**Sponsored by Alexandra Crawford, Student Affairs Committee Chair; Kiren Macleod, Student Affairs Committee Member, and Jesse Wren, Public Relations Director**

WHEREAS,

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long-term best interests of the Student Association in the formulation of University policy and in the fulfillment of the University's mission; and
- Each academic building on Truman's campus offers a variety of resources for student use, including computer stations, printers, gender neutral and accessible bathrooms, and water bottle filling stations; and
- Many students may not be aware of the resources available to them in each academic building due to the lack of advertisement; and
- Posting maps in each academic building and in a central location on Truman's website could help students navigate these buildings and be more aware of the resources available to them; and
- The Student Affairs Committee has updated the current academic building maps by outlining services accessible to students in each academic building, including computer stations, printers, gender neutral and accessible bathrooms, and water bottle filling stations;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT,

- Has compiled detailed maps of each academic building and the resources accessible to students through the Truman State University website<sup>1</sup> as well as each of the physical academic building maps; and

- Encourages students to use the accessible computer stations, printers, gender neutral and accessible bathrooms, and water bottle filling stations identified in each academic building at their convenience; and
- Requests that these maps are distributed to students for their use immediately through the Truman State University website and each of the academic buildings; and
- Requests that changes to these maps are updated as needed by Truman IT and Physical Plant through the Truman State University website and each of the academic buildings.
- Requests that changes to these maps are advertised for new and current Truman students on Student Government's social media by the Student Government's Public Relations Director.
