



**Student Government Resolution 120.011**  
**A Resolution Allocating the Budget for the Construction of the Labyrinth**  
**Sponsored by Jesse Wren, Treasurer; Ethan Kershaw, Environmental Affairs Committee**  
**Chair**

WHEREAS,

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long term best interest of the Student Association in the formulation of University policy and in the fulfillment of the University mission; and
- Construction of the Labyrinth project will begin in the spring of 2021; and
- Griffith Construction will install an approximately 500 square foot paver system as per the specs and plans provided<sup>1</sup>; and
- Total allocation for labor, material, and equipment to complete the project totals \$4,350;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT,

- The Student Government of Truman State University should spend no more than \$5,000 to fund the construction of the Labyrinth on the grounds of Truman State University.
