  - i) No report

  - i) Cooper:

    - (3) Met with Laura to discuss committee name change; is concerned about clarity of Equity Committee

    - (1) Have set up meetings for both divestment projects -- Dr. Hughes Monday and Bulldog Investment Fund next Sunday
    - (2) Earth Week planning has started

  - i) MacLeod:
    - All the revisions on the resolution from last meeting have been done -was not able to find information for every suggestion, but it is much stronger now
    - (2) Waiting on response from contact regarding JoEllen Engelbart memorial
    - (3) Had another meeting with Covid Stops With Us committee -- gave her contact info to get into Zoom meetings
  - ii) Barker: When do you meet with the Covid Stops With Us committee?
    - (1) MacLeod: They meet at noon on either Tuesday or Thursday depending on the week; also designated a few people on my committee to attend
