STUDENT GOVERNMENT EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING November 4, 2020

Called to order: 7:51 p.m.

- 1) Preliminary Items
 - a) Roll Call
- 2) Auxiliary Reports
 - a) Speaker of the Student Senate
 - i) No report
 - **b)** Academic Affairs Committee Chair
 - i) Purinton:
 - (1) Jessica wants to get student messages to give to departments on posters (for faculty appreciation week)
 - (a) Contacted printing services, 18x24 posters for 27 departments for \$492
 - (b) Lesch: Maybe have students sign/decorate poster board for their own department (more personal, less expensive)
 - (c) Alexander: Could table in locations close to these classes, but issues with what buildings we can table in
 - (d) Purinton: I didn't want to do tabling because it's a very busy time of the semester. Also issues with shared markers and craft supplies.
 - (e) Montúfar: Could also go through Vista Print or something that would be cheaper than printing services
 - (f) Alexander: Could they be normal poster size? Instead of the larger size?
 - (i) Purinton: I wanted larger sizes to put as many student messages as possible
 - (g) Myers: Do we have enough time to get messages and get the posters printed in time for the event?
 - (h) Montúfar: Do we need to get them U&I approved? If not, would go much faster
 - (i) Purinton: Just need to give them to the departments, not planning on U&I approval
 - (i) E. Smith: Usually schools don't have to get things approved to put them up in their own buildings
 - (j) Alexander: Not sure if we can spend almost \$500 on something that doesn't specifically go to students; small departments might not need larger posters; so, maybe going with smaller posters?
 - (k) German: Are we doing anything for staff?
 - (i) Purinton: My hope would be that everyone would mention the secretaries and other staff, but this idea has been the only one that has been feasible
 - (l) E. Smith: Another consideration would be changing it to the schools themselves rather than the individual departments (so 6

schools with large posters); could also make a staff poster in addition

- (i) Alexander: If you want to go this route, we can get it going quickly; get an all-school email out; if you like this idea, get back to us with the cost

 - (b) Tillman: Could students donate their meals for students who are in quarantine?
 - (i) Montúfar: That is really hard to do for some reason, but could try
 - (c) Wren: Setting up help line for quarantine students? For requesting food, etc.?
 - (d) E. Smith: Could we do a volunteer-based system for delivering food via request?

 - (f) Brought up credit/no credit option; this goes through faculty governance, so will need to reach out to Dr. Alberts
