- i) Alexander: No changes from last week, largest expense is turf for baseball fields and general maintenance; expenses for bussing from covid precautions and transportation
- ii) Questions:
  - (1) Myers: Are the barbells for the athletic weight room or the general weight room?
    - (a) Alexander: For the athletic weight room specifically
  - (2) Grandstaff: \$57,000 unspent restroom project?
    - (a) Alexander: Passed funds to build restrooms outside of Cambell, came up under budget, so have an extra \$60,000 from the remaining funds
  - (3) O. Smith: Is there any plan to make the outfield turf in addition to the infield?
    - (a) Alexander: Currently, infield is the priority, might be something they consider down the road
  - (4) Montúfar: Do we generally fund operations?
    - (a) Alexander: No, but based on the ballot language, there is no reason to believe we can't
    - (b) Montúfar: Is there a timeline on funding charter busses?
    - (c) Alexander: Talked with Jerry, but never heard back from him when sports were cancelled for the fall; we think this is a fair use of the fee; wanted to make sure this was a clear line item in the slate for transparency
  - (5) Bates: Should frontrun software be included?
    - (a) Alexander: We decided to take it out, not funding anything that doesn't have a dollar amount included
    - (b) Bates: You might ask Matt to make those changes
  - (6) O. Smith: Inflatable turtle?
    - (a) Alexander: Basically a moveable/inflatable backstop for batting practice
