

Student Government Resolution 121.001

A Resolution Allocating the Budget for Truman Week 2021

Sponsored by Shania Montúfar, President of the Student Association; Ethan Kershaw, Vice President; Jesse Wren, Treasurer

WHEREAS,

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long term best interest of the Student Association in the formulation of University policy and in the fulfillment of the University mission; and
- Truman Week 2021 takes place on August 18th through 20th; and
- Truman Week is an orientation program for new first year students at Truman; and
- Truman Week is a transition process with the purpose of helping new students adapt to living at Truman State University after leaving home; and
- Student Government annually works to promote awareness of the role it has on campus through a presence during Truman Week, in order to encourage new students to participate in Student Government and welcome them to the Truman community; and
- The 2020-2021 Student Government allocated the following amounts for Truman Week 2021:
 - \$2000 for Giveaways
 - \$1000 for Student Housing and Meals
 - \$300 for Truman Week Activity Co-Sponsorship
 - \$400 for Collaborative Giveaways with SAB and FAC
 - \$700 miscellaneous; and
- This allocation totals \$4400;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT,

- Plans to spend no more than \$4,400 to fund Student Government activities during the 2021 Truman Week program.

THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT DIRECTS THAT,
