

STUDENT GOVERNMENT RESOLUTION 072.004
Resolution Creating a Safe Rides Pilot Program

WHEREAS,

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long-term interests of the Student Association in the formulation of University policy and in the fulfillment of the University mission; and
- Many Greek organizations on campus provide safe rides to their members, putting an emphasis on risk management; and
- Not every student at Truman State University has access to safe rides through the Greek system; and
- The Missouri Student Association provides a great service to its students through STRIPES (Supportive Tigers Riding In Pursuit of Ensuring Safety), a responsible rides program on the University of Missouri – Columbia’s campus; and
- A campus wide SAFE RIDES PROGRAM does not exist at Truman State University

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT,

- The Student Government shall create, upon presentation of report, survey, and approval of budget request and administrative rules, a SAFE RIDES PILOT PROGRAM to last no longer than Spring '08, with a review of the pilot program to take place at the end of the Spring '08 semester; and
- The President of the Student Government shall create an ad hoc committee to create administrative rules of the SAFE RIDES PILOT PROGRAM and present its rules, report, survey and budget to the Student Government for final approval by the end of the Fall '07 semester; and
The members of the ad hoc committee shall consist of a chair and at least two voting members of the Student Government; and
- The SAFE RIDES PILOT PROGRAM will take effect February 1, 2008 semester; and
- The Student Government shall adequately publicize the SAFE RIDES PILOT PROGRAM.
