

Student Government Resolution 072.005
A Resolution on Early Registration

WHEREAS,

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long term best interest of the Student Association in the formulation of the University policy and in the fulfillment of the University mission; and
- The current class registration policy states that students register by credit hour. Students registration is staggered, those with the most credits register first and those with the least register last; and
- No group of students currently has a precedence in registration over any other group, other than by credit hour; and
- Many, if not all, groups have comparable rationales concerning time commitments; and
- The overwhelming student opinion as perceived by the Senate is against changing this policy in favor of athletes registering early.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT,

- The Student Government of Truman State University for the 2007-2008 academic year is opposed to any individual group of students being allowed to register prior to other students, within the context of the current system.

THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT OF TRUMAN STATE UNIVERSITY DIRECTS THAT,

- Additional copies of the resolution be disseminated to Provost Gordon; Dean Gilchrist; and the Truman Media Network.
