

**Student Government Resolution 082.010**  
**A Resolution to Set Up Two Recycle Bins on the Quad**

WHEREAS,

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long term best interest of the Student Association in the formulation of the University policy and in the fulfillment of the University mission; and
- Currently there are no outdoor recycle bins anywhere on campus, limiting recycling capabilities to only indoor facilities; and
- Many students already make use of the recycling options available inside Residential Halls, Academic Buildings, and the Student Union Building; and
- The recycling program at Truman State University has been nationally recognized in the 2007 Recyclemania program, gaining 3rd place out of 201 schools for recycling paper materials and 4th place out of 201 schools for recycling bottles and cans.
- The bins are funded completely by non-senate student organizations, which shows the support and commitment of the general student body.
- The recycle bins will demonstrate Truman State University's commitment to sustainability.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT,

- The Student Government of Truman State University should sponsor two recycling bins around the quadrangle area of campus.

THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT OF TRUMAN STATE UNIVERSITY DIRECTS THAT,

- Additional copies of this resolution are disseminated to President Darrell Kruger, Dean of Student Affairs Lou Ann Gilchrist, Physical Plant Director Karl Schneider, and the all organizations which helped fund the recycle bins, including Tau Lambda Sigma, Delta Zeta, Phi Sigma Pi, Sigma Kappa, and Alpha Sigma Alpha.
