

An Executive Order Establishing a Governing Documents Review Board of the Student Government

WHEREAS,

- The Student Government is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long term best interest of the Student Association in the formulation of University policy and in the fulfillment of the University's mission; and
- Several pressing issues which necessitate changes to the Student Government Governing Documents have become apparent over the Spring 2022 semester and the beginning of the Fall 2022 semester; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT,

- I, Kennedy Cooper, President of the Student Association, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Standing Rules of the Student Government, do issue this executive order to establish a Governing Documents Review Board; and
- Authorize this committee to consider the following items related to the Student Government governing documents:
 - Resolve inconsistencies between governing documents and eliminate erroneous or needlessly long sections of the Standing Rules
 - Adjust the attendance policy
 - Clarify the elections procedure adopted during the 2021-2022
 - Add Public Relations rules and standards to the standing rules
 - Update university department names in the in the Governing Documents
 - Consider making the Governing Documents Review Board a standing or secondary committee
 - Any other adjustments deemed necessary by the Governing Documents Review Board Chair and the Executive Board; and
- Appoint Alicia Stout, Speaker of the Student Senate, Chair of the Governing Documents Review Board; and
- Encourages members of the Student Government, and Student Association to apply to be on the committee; and
- Authorize this committee to meet on an as-needed basis, and that absences from Committee meetings not count against members' allotted number of absences; and
- Request that the Chair and members of the Governing Documents Review Board draft an end of the year report to document their discussions and progress; and
- Authorize the Governing Documents Review Board until the 2023 Spring Transitional meeting and subject, commensurate with Article I, Section 3, Clause 5 in the Constitution of the Truman State University Student Government, to renewal by the 2023-2024 administration of the Student Government
